We are **Breast Cancer Survivors** who ride motorcycles to High Schools educating Junior and Senior girls on the importance of early breast cancer detection (self breast exams) while raising Breast Cancer Awareness.

Most Survivors in this group did not ride motorcycles prior to joining BRA. They conquered their fears by taking a motorcycle safety class to get license. The courage they displayed while learning how to safely ride a motorcycle was inspiring, especially considering some were going through cancer treatments. All are heroes!

The group discovered a 16 year old girl from Seattle that died of Breast Cancer and recently (2009) a 10 year old from California diagnosed with Stage III Breast Cancer. Because of these discoveries, BRA is determined to educate and promote the importance of Early Breast Cancer detection.
